TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE CLUB:

It is necessary to forward to the above address an application on the proper **Membership Proposal** form which is attached.

This Membership Proposal form must be completed by an existing member of the Club (the Proposer)*. The Membership Proposal form must be **signed by the Proposer and Seconder** accompanied by **two letters of support**, one from the Proposer and one from the Seconder who is also a member.

The Proposal will then be considered by the Commodore, and if accepted, the applicant will be asked to complete an **Application for Membership** form which is to be returned with a cheque for:

The applicant will be asked to attend a short informal evening lecture on boat safety and other matters relevant to Club members. Family members and crew are also cordially invited to attend.

The boat and trailer will then need to be submitted for an inspection, and when passed, the applicant becomes a full member of the Outboard Boating Club of Auckland Inc.

Members are expected to abide by the Rules and By-laws of the Club, and take an active interest in the wide variety of the Club's affairs.
