High Tide 1254hrs 3.0m

Low Tide 0626hrs 1.0m

Member Briefing

1045hrs. (Make sure your vessel is in the water by 1030hrs and ready to go!)

Club Departure

1100hrs from the Club – take your time. Stick to speed limits.

Arrival

Approximately 1130hrs at The Riverhead

Suggested Departure from Riverhead

No later than 1430hrs. Approximately one and a half hours after high tide. Skippers are requested to drop other skippers out to their anchored vessel before picking up their guest from the dock.

Drop Off

Vessels without tenders, drop your guests off at the jetty then anchor midstream. Skippers will be picked up by other available craft to get back to shore. Before vessel owners anchor, please do a circuit to collect other 'anchored' skippers. This will ensure everyone gets onshore quicker.
